What we do:

- Develop and assess student success and retention initiatives
- Answer questions about academic concerns beyond the scope of faculty members or advisors
- Process absence notifications, personal/medical leave of absences and withdrawals
- Oversee Academic Standards and monitor students on academic probation
- Receive academic integrity violations and initiate honor council follow-up
- · Review academic policies and work with students who request exceptions to policies
- Develop programs that promote first generation student success
- Oversee Academic Components of Messina and the Ignatius Scholars Program
- · Recognize first-year students who make the Dean's List

Throughout the year, we will ask you for information that helps us support students by submitting:

- Progress reports (student athletes, probation students, Ignatian Scholars- submitted via e-mail)
- Class Roster Verification (week 1 or 2 of the semester submitted through Self -Service)
- <u>Midterm Action Reports</u> (submitted through Self-Service)
- Incomplete and Failure Reports (submitted through Self-Service)
- Honor Code Violations

- Students with prolonged absences (1-2 weeks) without communication
- Behavioral changes (appearance, attentiveness)
- Student not responsive to outreach and is in danger of failing course
